"I Choose You"

"This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." Matthew 4: v. 17

In my last church position, I was the music coordinator for Westminster Presbyterian Church in Dubuque, Iowa. Whenever I was looking for new anthems, I found the music catalogs from the different publishers very useful. Almost all of them included sample CD's of their newly released songs. I would listen to them in my car on my commute. If I wasn't impressed, I could ff to the next one. In the fall of 2007, the Beckenhorst Press catalog had a recording of the anthem we're singing today. I ordered it immediately and it became a big favorite with my choir.

When I began my position at First Presbyterian, I was looking around the choir room and cleaning a few old things off the bookshelf. Imagine my surprise when I found a copy of the same catalog from 2007! I took that as a positive sign that I should add "I Choose You" to our choir library.

The text makes it a perfect general-purpose anthem, but I like it most for baptism services. As part of our Presbyterian Heritage Sunday, it reinforces the belief that the choice of our faith journey goes both ways. We also sang it for Pastor John's installation. The words of the chorus: "I choose you to live with me forever" express very clearly the bond with our Creator affirmed through the rite of baptism. The instrumental obbligato even suggests the image of the dove soaring overhead at the baptism of Jesus.
