John Ylvisaker (b. 1937) is probably best known as the composer of the popular contemporary hymn, "I Was There to Hear Your Borning Cry". Born in Morehead, Minnesota, he graduated from Concordia College. His career includes teaching high school music, conducting church choirs, and producing SCAN, a weekly radio program of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.

Ylvisaker is renowned for his astute paraphrases of Biblical texts. He is also widely regarded as a composer of tunes that are accessible for congregational singers. In the case of our anthem, his original poem has been coupled with the Scottish folk song, "Wild Mountain Thyme" to create a sensitive tribute to those we have lost, made more powerful by the addition of the violin solo. It is a thoughtful expression for All Souls, as we remember those who have gone before us.
