How Do We Make Your Giving Stretch So Far for Mission?

This past year, we collected dozens of suitcases for foster kids, thousands of pounds of food for hungry neighbors, warm coats, and disaster kits for Presbyterian Disaster Assistance. We also offered a spa-like renewal day and Thanksgiving Dinner for women rebuilding their lives at Brand New Mercies—and much more.

For a congregation our size, the impact is remarkable. *How is that possible?* For several years, we've focused on three force multipliers:

Technology

When we collected suitcases, one-third came through social media. Non-members donated funds and luggage. By shopping smart at five thrift stores, we turned a \$100 online gift into 11 suitcases. We are now beginning to receive support from online friends for our digital ministry.


Partnerships

Each year we team up with the Boy Scouts for Souper Bowl Sunday. Their partnerships with local grocery stores helped us gather nearly 3,000 pounds of food this year, which we shared with six ministry partners fighting hunger.

Grants

We hosted a health and wellness day for women from two partner ministries. Local businesses donated services, and a Presbytery grant covered the remaining costs.
