

### **“Welcome Table”**

Food and fellowship have bonded people throughout history. During the Exodus, God provided manna to sustain the Israelites. As Laura reminded us in her sermon last week, Esther used a feast to expose Haman’s plot to exterminate the Jews. When Jesus visited the home of Mary and Martha, one of them couldn’t be distracted from her dinner preparations. When Jesus recruited his first apostles, they were fishermen. Even the Sermon on the Mount is known almost as much for the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes as the Beatitudes.

Jesus’ final earthly gathering with the Apostles was the Last Supper. This meal, in which he offered His body and blood, became the template for the Christian Eucharist. PC-USA offers the Lord’s Supper to all Christians, no matter what their denomination. Many events celebrated in our church center on a shared meal and the fellowship it provides, from our potlucks to our Monte Ne dinners. “Welcome Table” is an energetic reminder to us as Christians of the metaphor of the Heavenly feast for all believers.
