

Anthem Note

“None Other Lamb”

In 1892, Christina Rosetti published her last major book, *The Face of the Deep*. It was a reflection on *The Revelation of John*, a collection of essays with poems included throughout. At this point of her life, her personal faith was challenged because of failing health and the deaths of her mother and brother. “None Other Lamb” is her response to the opening verses of Revelation 5:”

“Then I saw in the right hand of him who sat on the throne a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals. And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming in a loud voice, “Who is worthy to break the seals and open the scroll?”

I wept and wept because no one was found who was worthy to open the scroll or look inside. Then one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals.”

Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing at the center of the throne.”

A number of composers have set Rosetti’s poem to music. Craig Courtney has chosen to do so using a simple accompaniment and straightforward voicing to highlight the powerful text. Its reflective nature makes it an appropriate anthem for the season of Lent, as we remember the sacrifice of Jesus and his resurrection and the promise of redemption for our sins.
