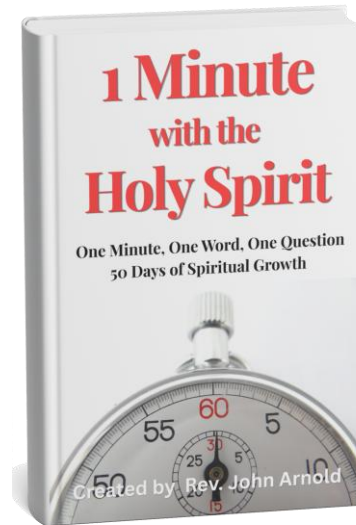

“Go Ye Into All the World”

Eugene Butler (b. 1935) earned his Bachelor of Music Education from Oklahoma University. He went on to earn his Master of Sacred Music from Union Theological Seminary in New York and his Doctor of Musical Arts in Composition from the University of Missouri, Kansas City. Living in Overland Park, Kansas, Dr. Butler served as Director of Choral Activities and Music Theory at Johnson County Community College. In addition, he spent 28 years as Director of Music and the Arts at Valley View United Methodist Church in Overland Park and conducted the Johnson County Chorus, a community Choir made up of singers from the Kansas City Area. In 1998, he retired from all teaching and conducting positions to devote his time to composing. Dr. Butler has over 700 musical compositions to his credit.

“Go Ye Into All the World” was composed in 1974 and has been a favorite with many church choirs. This song is in a rondo form. After an initial theme section with a driving beat, contrasting B and C sections are presented, always returning to A with its charge to share the Gospel message everywhere.
